

# Somervell County 4-H Scholarship Application Form

## GUIDELINES:

- Scholarships will be awarded by BOTH the Glen Rose 4-H Club and Glen Rose 4-H Shooting Sports Club (applicants will specify the Club) to seniors who meet the requirements set forth by the Somervell County 4-H Scholarship Committee.
- Scholarship money may be used for a technical school, junior/community college, or university. This excludes any correspondence courses.
- The scholarship is awarded in May and must be claimed by December 31 of the following school year.
- Scholarship recipients must provide proof of enrollment and proper contact information for direct dispersal to the institution.

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have participated in 4-H in the current school year (preference given to 4+ years of participation)
- Must be an active member of **4-H**
  - **Meeting attendance (attend at least 60% of enrollment time)**
  - **Practice attendance**
  - **Project participation**
  - **Community Service attendance**
  - **Fundraising participation**
  - **Leadership Roles**
    - **Sign in logs and other documentation used for verification.**
- Must have participated in 4-H during the current school year.
- A letter of recommendation from an **educator** be submitted with the complete application form on time to the County Extension Office or by mail in a sealed envelope.
- A **character letter from a community member, who is not related to the applicant, must** be submitted with the complete application form on time to the County Extension Office or by mail in a sealed envelope.
- A high school transcript including the Fall Semester of the graduating year.
- Complete at least two **Record Books**.

## SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- The County Extension Agents will select a committee to review the applications.
- Review of applications will be conducted anonymously.
- The committee will place a major emphasis on the applicant's involvement in 4-H.
- All application requirements must be met to be considered for this scholarship.
- The committee will select a recipient(s) who best meets all the application requirements.
